



School Aims

To work in partnership with Governors, Parents and the LA to establish and maintain a school that will:

1. provide a learning environment for pupils, staff and all members of the community, that is well-structured, happy and stimulating.
2. provide a curriculum that balances individual needs with the requirements of the National Curriculum and which enables every pupil to fulfil their greatest potential.
3. welcome all parents and carers and encourage them to be part of the team responsible for the overall development of their children.
4. equip the pupils with the skills, knowledge and attitudes that will enable them to become self-motivated and independent learners.
5. provide an environment in which all pupils learn to respect themselves, each other and the environment, learning to tolerate and to value individual differences.
6. help pupils develop appropriate social and moral values and an awareness of their responsibilities in the wider community.
7. help all pupils to value and respect the diversity of culture, religion, language and gender in a multi-cultural society.
8. provide the pupils with the skills, knowledge and attitudes that will enable them to live fulfilling and productive lives when they have left school.
9. give access to mainstream classes whenever and wherever it is appropriate for individual pupils, within the constraints of the School's organisation and resources.
10. to give all pupils access to a range of leisure and working experiences within the community.
11. give access to a variety of learning environments and teaching styles, appropriate to the age of the pupils, in preparation for further educational experiences.
12. develop a clearly defined system of pastoral care that will, with the support of other agencies, ensure the physical and emotional well-being of all pupils.
13. give opportunities for all staff to develop their personal and professional skills.
14. develop links with other professional services so that all staff and colleagues feel that they are working as valued members of a multi-disciplinary team.
15. provide and develop the highest quality resources for all pupils.
16. develop the role of the School in the context of the wider communities of Woodsetton, Sedgley and Dudley.
