Welcome back to Summer Term!



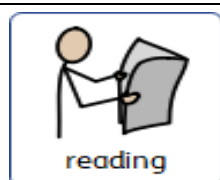
Our PE days are Wednesdays and Fridays. Please make sure your child has their PE kit to keep in school and is clearly labelled. On a Wednesday we visit Crystal Leisure Centre. Your child can come into school wearing suitable clothing but please send in their school uniform as we will be supporting them with their dressing skills.



Life skills—This half term the children will be developing their play skills. This will encourage the children to develop their turn taking skills as well as learning how to share with others.



On **Wednesdays** we will continue to visit to Crystal Leisure Centre for soft play as part of our Physical Development curriculum. This will take place in the morning session. Can the children come dressed in appropriate comfortable clothing.



The children access books every day. They are encouraged to explore books by looking at the pictures and turning the pages. The staff sit 1;1 with each child to read their own reading book and this is changed once a week.





Our topic this half term is **Down on the Farm**

Through our topic, we will be learning about farmyard animals and food. We will explore this through practical tasks and recorded activities.

We will continue to provide a communication and language rich environment. Children will have access to a range of communication aids, as well as support from adults in the class. Along with this, we will be encouraging the children to build phonemic awareness and begin to build on their reading skills.

In Maths, we will continue to develop our knowledge of number and will be exploring numbers around us. We will also be exploring shapes and measures and will explore applying such skills in different contexts and situations.

We will also be exploring our topic through sensory play and technology. We will also have as strong focus on the development of social skills and developing respect and understanding of our own feelings.
