

# Caterpillar Class Curriculum Newsletter

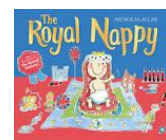
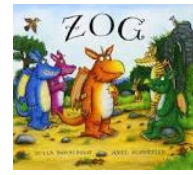
