Dear Parents / Carers

May I start this letter by saying a huge thank you to everyone for all of your continued patience and understanding throughout the challenging times that we have experienced during recent months.

As we look forward to September, following latest guidance from the government, DfE and LA, it is expected that children will be returning to school as normal, however we are all too well aware that things can change very quickly with minimal notice.

We have planned for a range of possible scenarios, and based upon the scenario that we are able to return to school as normal in September, I would like to share with you how school will be structured for the next academic year.

From September we will be returning to teaching the majority of pupils in single age year groups. A small group of KS2 pupils with significant complex needs will be taught in a new specially created class called "Woodpeckers" where a more sensory, practical approach will cater more effectively to their individual needs.

These changes will also enable all classes sizes to be smaller in number than those currently in place providing better teaching and learning opportunities for all pupils, particularly in respect of lost face to face learning during lock down.

Every parent will be contacted separately to notify you of your child's class next year.

I look forward to hopefully seeing you all back in school in September.
