What is the Local Offer?

Every council must by law publish a Local Offer. In Dudley this is called Dudley's Local Offer. It tells you what support is on offer for children and young people with special educational needs (SEN) and or disabilities and their families.

Who is Dudley's Local Offer for?

- Children and young people with special educational needs (SEN) and or disabilities, from birth to 25
- Their parents, families and carers
- Practitioners and professionals



What does Dudley's Local Offer website include?

The website is split into four key age ranges

- 0 - 5 years
- 5 - 11 years
- 11 - 16 years
- 16 - 25 years

Simply click on the age range you need to find lots of up to date, relevant information, guidance and support to that age range.

General information and SEN guidance relating to all ages, along with information for parents and carers can also be found. There is a bulletin board, recommended reading and viewing and celebratory areas - a family zone and young people's zone.
