Happy New Year! I hope you have all had a lovely break over Christmas. Let's hope we all have a happy and safe 2023 making lots of memories.





Our topic this half term is **Happily Ever After**.

In the topic we will be exploring a range of traditional tales including Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs, The Princess and the Pea and Little Red Riding Hood. We will be exploring these tales in detail and linking these into our Science and Art lessons.

The children will be developing their fine motor skills through Squiggle Whilst you Wiggle activities and a range of threading/pincer activities. Their gross motor skills will be supported by PE lessons with RB Sports and Worcester Cricket as well as activity time on our adventure playground and in our forest area.

We will be working on the children's communication and interaction skills with Bucket Time sessions and opportunities for role-play and team games. We will also be using colourful semantics to help build up and develop your child's communication. I will send out more information on this soon.

Within Maths, the children will be exploring a range of number and shape activities involving aspects of the weekly stories.


