We will be having PE on **Tuesday's** and **Friday's**. Please make sure your child has their PE kit to keep in school and is labelled.




Our forest day is on a **Wednesday** afternoon. Can your child bring forest clothes in a labelled bag on the day. We also need a pair of wellies to keep in school.

Our topic this half term is **'Home Sweet Home'**.

In the topic we will be learning about our special people such as our family, main features of a house, different types of houses and homes and furniture from the past and present. They will also have the opportunity to program and direct Beebots.

We will be looking at stories that link with our topic, these include; *My Mum is Fantastic*, *Owl Babies*, *The story of the Zodiac*, *A zoo in our house*, *The Gruffalo*, *The Three Little Pigs*, *Jack and the Beanstalk* and *Hansel and Gretel*.

We will be exploring Animals including Humans, everyday materials and plants. The children will learn about the different stages in a human life, parts of our bodies, different senses and to learn about where different animals live.

We will encourage the children to get creative and create pictures in different ways using a range of media. They will be painting and drawing pictures of a range of toys and will be making houses and characters related to the stories we have been learning about.

Building on your child's previous learning and knowledge; our work in maths is based around the areas of number, shape, time and measurement. The using and applying of our Maths skills will be highlighted throughout all our learning opportunities.
