Our topic this half term is '**Colours, Colours Everywhere**'.

In the topic we will be covering building our knowledge of recognising and sorting colours through a variety of activities. We will be experiencing stories linked to colour and will be singing songs and rhymes. We will also be thinking about ourselves and recognising and identifying body parts and facial features through a variety of activities.

We will be providing an environment for the children to express themselves and develop their language and communication skills. Along with this we will be encouraging the children to discover phonemic awareness and begin to build on an ability to start reading. All children will also be guided in developing skills with numbers and calculations, as well as being able to describe shapes, spaces and measures. Through Understanding the world we will be making sense of things by observing and exploring everything from places we spend time to the technology that we use. We will also be drawing, playing with paint, instruments and technology to express ourselves and learn new things. We will have as strong focus on the development of social skills and developing respect and understanding of our own feelings.
