



### PE and Sport Premium Grant 2016-17

The government provides school with a PE and Sports Grant, aimed at improving the provision of PE and sport so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles.

In the academic year of 2016-17, Woodsetton School received £8415.

The grant received by school was used as follows:

- Further develop teaching and learning in PE through developing staff expertise
- Improve resources to support the development of the subject
- Increase pupils' participation in sports and physical activities
- Increase opportunities for pupils to take part in a range of competitive sports
- Improve pupils' physical well-being and lifestyles
- Contribute towards maintenance / replenishment of playground equipment

### Impact/evaluation

We evaluate the impact of the Sports Premium funding as part of our normal self-evaluation and curriculum mapping arrangements.

- Pupils have partaken in a number of sporting activities / competitions outside the main PE curriculum
- Due to an increase this year in the number of specialist sessions, more pupils have had access to development of skills by specialist coaches
- Staff have received ongoing professional development opportunities to further develop their subject knowledge and skill set in a range of areas of PE
- Outdoor adventure area has been well maintained so to enable pupils to access this area for as much of the year as possible
