Overview

This is what we will be looking at for the first half of the Summer Term.



Maths

Number and Place Value - Sequencing numbers, identifying tens and ones, comparing numbers, counting in steps of 2, 5 and 10

Addition and Subtraction - Number bonds, recalling addition and subtraction facts, solving single and multiple step problems

Multiplication and division - Groups of, lots of, arrays, sharing, times table practice, fractions

Capacity - Using measuring jugs and cylinders, comparing volume of containers, more and less, full and empty, ordering capacity

Time - Days of the week, analogue clocks, O'clock / half past / quarter past, ordering events in the day and week

Phonics

The children will be completing daily phonics lessons to help them progress through the Letters and Sounds scheme. The children will be working individually, in pairs and small groups, using the phonics resources in class and online.

Mini Topics

Geography - Town and Country (UK)

The children will be looking at 3 settings within the UK—Dudley (a town), the countryside and the seaside. The children will be learning about the human and physical features of each setting and how they are similar or different.

Science - Electricity

The children will be learning where electricity comes from, what we use electricity for, different sources of power and how to complete a circuit. The children will also be taught the safety around using electricity.

RE - A helping hand

The children will be learning about how we help others, the message Jesus gave us about helping others and how Sikhs follow the message of Guru Nanak.

PSHE - VIPs

The children will be learning about Healthy and Unhealthy relationships, Trust and Secrets.
