The school is committed to working positively together with Parents and all family members, and this charter shows how we see our respective responsibilities during this current time.

<p>The school will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• always keep the pupils and staff as safe as possible• not attend school if they or anyone in their household is displaying any of the main symptoms of COVID-19 and arrange a test asap• ensure all staff arrive at school in clean clothes every day• provide ample cleaning equipment to ensure all resources and learning areas are clean• adjust the school day to allow staggered learning, breaks and start/end times• provide ample amounts of sanitation liquid, soap, handwash and paper towels and adequate facilities to enable everyone to wash hands regularly and safely access toilets• ensure all staff sanitise/wash their hands when they arrive and continue to wash/sanitise them throughout the day and model this to pupils• prepare all resources needed for each day's activities and be ready for pupils when they arrive• ensure visual and practical measures are put into place to ensure social distancing is adhered to as much as possible• set out clear expectations and guidance for staff and pupils to follow in line with government expectations• inform parents of any updates to guidance as quickly as possible• provide an appropriate curriculum based on individual needs of pupils• provide home learning opportunities when it is not safe or possible to partake in face to face learning <p>Signed.....(Headteacher)</p>	<p>The parents/carers will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• keep their child at home if they are displaying any of the main symptoms including those identified as the wider symptoms of COVID-19 and notify school immediately• keep their child at home if someone in the household is displaying symptoms and/or has tested positive for Covid-19• ensure their child is fit and well before sending their child into school• notify school if their child is unwell and will not be attending school prior to 9.00a.m.• ensure school has up to date contact details so that in the event of an emergency, parents can be contacted swiftly to pick up their child• agree to picking up their child as quickly as possible but no more than 30 minutes if school believes they are displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or is concerned about their health in any way• ensure their child comes to school every day in clean uniform/home clothes and is suitably dressed for PE/forest school• ensure their child arrives and is dropped off and picked up at the allocated times for each class• ensure that only one adult brings and collects their child from school and ideally does not bring siblings with them.• ensure their child brings to school their own drinking cup / water bottle and takes it home for washing every day after school• adhere to social distancing at all times whilst on school premises and wear a face covering at all times <p>Signed..... (Parent/carers)</p>	<p>The pupil will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• arrive at school at the allocated time in clean uniform/home clothes every day• bring with them their own water bottle/ drinking cup and take it away with them at the end of the day for washing• wash their hands before leaving the house.• be encouraged to wash their hands as soon as they get to school and at various times throughout the day including before and after eating or use hand sanitiser when asked• be encouraged to listen to adults in their bubble and only use resources provided for them unless told otherwise• be encouraged to respect everyone's right to social distance and try to keep 2 metres away from other pupils and adults in school if possible• be encouraged to follow instructions given by adults in school and ask questions if they are unsure• encourage each other and support the school by being kind• tell an adult if they feel unwell at all• be encouraged to follow the 'Catch it, bin it, Kill it' message/rules• be supported when moving around school eg to go to the toilet and avoiding "out of bound" rooms• only learn/play in the places they have been assigned to <p>Signed.....
