<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • always keep the pupils and staff as safe as possible • ensure all staff arrive at school in clean clothes every day • provide ample cleaning equipment to ensure all resources and learning areas are clean • adjust the school day to allow staggered learning, breaks and start/end times • provide ample amounts of sanitation liquid, soap, handwash and paper towels and adequate facilities to enable everyone to wash hands regularly and safely access toilets • ensure all staff sanitise/wash their hands when they arrive and continue to wash/sanitise them throughout the day and model this to pupils • prepare all resources needed for each day's activities and be ready for pupils when they arrive • ensure visual and practical measures are put into place to ensure social distancing is adhered to as much as possible • set out clear expectations and guidance for staff and pupils to follow in line with government expectations • inform parents of any updates to guidance as quickly as possible 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • keep their child at home if they are displaying any symptoms of COVID-19 and notify school immediately • ensure their child is fit and well before sending their child into school • notify school prior to 9.00a.m. if their child is unwell and will not be attending • ensure school has up to date contact details so that in the event of an emergency, parents can be contacted swiftly to pick up their child • agree to picking up their child within a maximum of 30 minutes if school believes they are displaying symptoms of COVID-19 • ensure their child comes to school every day in clean uniform (home clothes on PE / Forest School days) • ensure their child arrives and is picked up at the allocated times for each class • ensure their child brings to school their own drinking cup / water bottle and takes it home for washing every day after school • adhere to social distancing at all times whilst on school premises • ensure their child has had suncream put on them before school when appropriate 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • arrive at school at the allocated time in clean uniform (home clothes on PE / Forest School days) • bring with them their own water bottle/ drinking cup and take it away with them at the end of the day for washing • wash their hands before leaving the house. • be encouraged to wash their hands as soon as they get to school and at various times throughout the day including before and after eating or use hand sanitiser when asked • be encouraged to listen to adults in their class and only use resources provided for them unless told otherwise • be encouraged to respect everyone's right to social distance • be encouraged to follow instructions given by adults in school and ask questions if they are unsure • encourage each other and support the school by being kind • tell an adult if they feel unwell at all • be encouraged to follow the 'Catch it, bin it, kill it' message/rules • be supported when moving around school eg to go to the toilet and avoiding "out of bound" rooms • only learn/play in the places they have been assigned to
